In your role as Committee Member of the LCEB, you will work with the school to advise on all matters related to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander education. **You will be required to:** 

- commit to attending 1-2 meetings per school term, (Weeks 3 and 9).
- share expert language and cultural advice/ information, exchange views, and partner
  with the school to support and enhance the learning experience and engagement of
  Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students, parents, and families.
- communicate directly with members outside of scheduled LCEB meetings to progress project tasks, where required.
- contribute to the distribution of information and updates to the broader community.
- reapply for membership of the LCEB every twelve months through an EOI process.

LCEB members will be renumerated for their skills, knowledge, and experience. Sitting fees will be paid to LCEB members for their expertise at scheduled meetings, and out of session advice and commitments.

## The objectives of our LCEB are to:

- 1. Increase the proportion of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students achieving a C or better in English and Mathematics.
- 2. Reduce the number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students receiving multiple school disciplinary absences.
- 3. Increase retention of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students from Year 10 to 12.
- 4. Improve the proportion of educators who strongly agree they are confident in embedding cultural perspectives.
- 5. Improve the attendance of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.
- 6. Increase the level of successful Year 12 completion and attainment of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students.
- 7. Increase local Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students transitioning into meaningful pathways post schooling.

Our LCEB acts in an advisory capacity, identifying Indigenous education priorities and makes recommendations on matters that impact the experience of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander students, parents, and communities in partnership with Kepnock SHS. Our LCEB holds a wealth of skills, knowledge, expertise, and connections.
