

Next Step 2021 Post-School Destinations

Kepnock State High School



This is a summary of the post-school destinations of students from Kepnock State High School who completed Year 12 and gained a Senior Statement in 2020. The results are from the *Year 12 Completers Survey*, which is conducted approximately six months after students completed Year 12.

76.5% response rate

104 out of 136 Year 12 completers from this school responded to the 2021 survey. *Results may not be representative of all Year 12 completers at this school.*

Post-school destinations



In 2021, 80.8% of Year 12 completers from Kepnock State High School were engaged in education, training or employment in the year after they completed school.



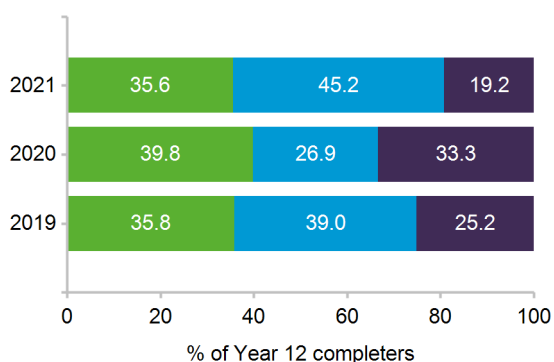
Of the 104 respondents, 35.6% continued in some recognised form of education and training. The most common study destination was VET certificate.



A further 45.2% transitioned directly into paid employment and no further study.

All Year 12 completers were assigned to a *main destination*. Respondents who were both studying and working are reported as being in education or training, including apprentices and trainees.
